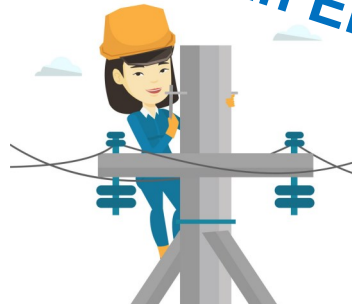

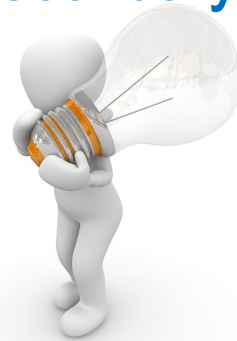

What does an Electrician do?

- Install, repair, test and service electrical systems, ensuring all electrical connections are safe and meet the electrical code



Where could an Electrician work?

- Working for electrical contractors, in maintenance departments of companies or be self-employed

What is needed to become an Electrician?

- Depending on the type of Electrician (**Construction or Residential**) 7200-9000 hours of on the job training is required
- Grade 10 or equivalent (Grade 12 or equivalent is recommended)
- Complete the Certificate of Qualification exam

How much money could an Electrician make?

- A Journeyperson Electrician could make \$30-44/hour
